SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

Welcome to Kids' College and Teen Program! Most classes are held at our three campus locations: Anaheim Campus, Cypress College, and the Wilshire Center in Fullerton. Class enrollment is limited and is on a first come, first served basis. Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment. Classes may be added after the schedule is printed. For the most-up-to-date listing, go to www.sce.edu and check the Kids' College section of the SCE Schedule. Some classes require supplies—please check with the office for specific supply lists. Register for classes on-line starting November 30, 2011; in-person registration begins December 1, 2011.

Parents are responsible for their own children. Each child should be accompanied by an adult to the first class to verify classroom location and future drop off and pick up points. Please note classes are dismissed 10 minutes earlier than the end time listed in the schedule so teachers and students have time to prepare for their next class. The registration receipt will show the exact class end time.

Parents/Legal Guardians: please be prepared to show identification when registering your child or requesting information regarding your child – this will ensure the safety of your child and complies with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Please complete an 'emergency form' for each child registering for class(es) to ensure our records are up-to-date.

Winter classes will begin January 28, 2012; please check individual classes for the actual start date.
All SCE offices will be closed and there will be no classes February 17-20, 2012.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Parents / legal guardians of first-time students can apply their child for a student identification (ID) number on-line at www.sce.edu via the Kids' College Registration link. Your child's student ID will be e-mailed to you within two (2) business days

Apply for your child's student ID in-person by coming into one of our three SCE campus locations. For faster service during peak registration periods, apply for the student ID before registration begins.

Each child must have obtained his or her own student ID number before registering for class.

Once you receive the ID, you have two (2) ways to register your child for classes:

ON-LINE REGISTRATION begins, November 30, 2011. Go to www.sce.edu, click the myGateway link, and use your child's 8-digit student ID (or SSN) as the User ID, and their six-digit date of birth (MMDDYY) as the password.

Computers for on-line registration are available at each SCE campus. On-line registration will continue until the day before the class starts.

IN-PERSON REGISTRATION begins December 1, 2011 and will continue until the class fills or beings. Parents may register a child for classes at any of our sites for any class, even if the class is not at that location.

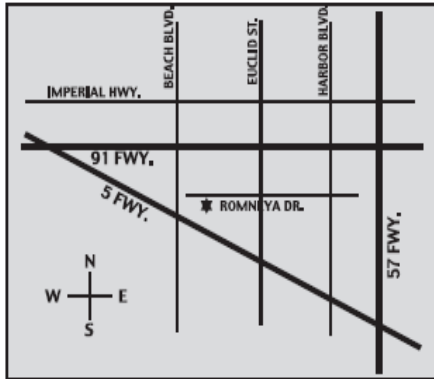

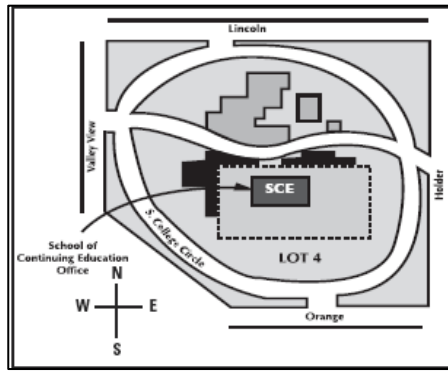

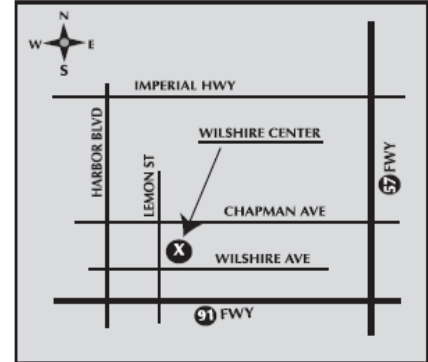
