

SCE Facts & Information

- The School of Continuing Education (SCE) is part of the North Orange County Community College District, which includes credit schools Cypress College and Fullerton College.
- What was to become SCE was established as Adult Education in 1930 as part of the Fullerton High School District.
- SCE is accredited by the Schools Commission of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).
- SCE's Pharmacy Technician Certificate Program is accredited by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists.
- SCE is the fourth largest noncredit program in California offering continuing education, community services and economic development courses.
- SCE offers four terms per year:
 - Winter Trimester (12 weeks): January - March
 - Spring Trimester (12 weeks): March - June
 - Summer Term (6 weeks): June – August
 - Fall Trimester (12 weeks): September - December
- SCE Academic Senate is one of only two noncredit senates in the state.
- SCE has three continuing education centers in Anaheim, Cypress, and Wilshire (Fullerton).
- SCE provides instruction at approximately 151 off-campus locations at community-based sites such as senior centers, community centers, elementary schools, etc.
- SCE served 33,742 unduplicated students in 2015/16.
- SCE offered approximately 800 courses each quarterly term in 2015/16.
- SCE generated 5,290 Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTES) hours in 2015/16.
- In 2015/16, SCE awarded 254 students with their high school diplomas.
- In 2015/16, SCE awarded 409 Career Technical Education certificates in the areas of Administrative Assistant, Early Childhood Education, Electrical Trainee, English as a Second Language (ESL)-Academic Success, Fundamental Computer Concepts & Skills, Funeral Service Assistant, Graphic Design & Web Skills, Management, Medical Assistant, Medical Device: Quality Assurance, Office Application Essentials, Pharmacy Technician, and Project Management.
- SCE has three ESL computer learning labs, one at each SCE Center location.
- SCE has three High School Diploma Program labs, one at each SCE Center location.
- SCE has three Learning Centers (tutoring/basic skills labs), one at each SCE Center location.
- SCE has a Business/Computer Skills lab at the Anaheim Campus.
- SCE has a 66-seat assessment center at the Anaheim Campus.
- SCE has a high-tech adaptive computer lab for disabled students located at the SCE Cypress Center.
- SCE Kids' College and Teen Program classes are designed to provide children with specialized academic and/or positive enrichment activities outside of the regular classroom experience. SCE offers over 125 courses each trimester and over 250 each summer term.
- SCE hosts the Training, Development, Innovation (TDI) business resource center with economic development grants to provide training and contracted services programs in the community college system in the areas of advanced manufacturing/technology and environmental compliance/health/safety/homeland security.
- 357 online classes (fee-based) are offered each term.
- SCE employs 26 full-time faculty positions: 18 teaching faculty and eight counselors, as well as approximately 336 part-time faculty.
- SCE employs 20 Managers (both general and grant-funded; includes three Deans and the Provost).
- SCE employs 71 Classified Staff members.
- SCE employs one Confidential Staff member.
